Guild overview and structure

The Guild which was founded in 1986, is an organisation of around 70 people who love wood and love to make things with it.

Each month 20 to 40 members are attracted to the evening meetings.

At these meetings, we may have a demonstration of say, woodturning, a joinery technique, or we may have a guest speaker on a relevant subject.

In June 2007 we began a partnership agreement with Cosgrove High School.

This gave us use of part of the school trade block, for meetings and activities. We have the exclusive use of a substantial area as a workshop. This we call 'The Guild Room'.

Our workshop is equipped with machinery, Including several band saws, 200mm planer, Thicknesser, sliding table bench saw, compound mitre saw and several wood lathes All of the machines are connected to a fully ducted dust extraction system.

The Guild machinery is available for member use. Where, depending on the machinery an hourly usage fee may be charged.

The club room will be available for members use on most Saturday mornings and other weekday nights, Generally, opening times will be dependent on member demand.

We circulate a Newsletter to all members; These are usually published in January, March, May, July, September and November.

Currently members are working to continue the fitting out of the Guild Room, with tools, machinery, and tea, coffee making facilities. A group gathers on the second Saturday each month as a box making Special Interest Group (SIG). The fourth Saturday each month is set aside for a woodturning SIG.

We maintain a substantial library of woodworking books and DVD's. The library and the facilities of the Guild Room are available for members use.
