Course description

An introduction to basic woodturning – safe lathe operating, dos and don'ts, secure wood mounting, tool selection, tool purpose, sharpening, correct presentation of tools, different techniques, spindle and bowl turning.

What is supplied

Wood lathe, basic woodturning tools, dust extraction, first piece of wood

What to bring

Woodturning tools (if you own some please bring them along)

Safety glasses

Face shield (mandatory for beginners)

Woodturning smock or overalls or dust coat

Sandpaper – 80 grit to 400 grit

Steel ruler, pencil & paper or note book
